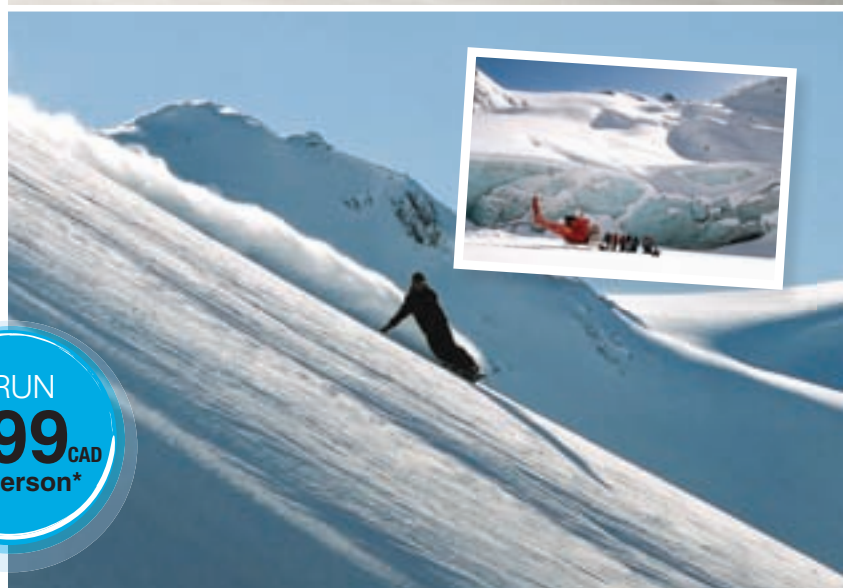

Intermediate

You can ski/board blue runs and occasionally attempt black runs. You may not have any powder experience.

Advanced

You have been skiing/boarding for years. Blue runs are easy and you routinely ski/board black runs. You enjoy and seek out powder snow.

Expert

You can ski/board almost any designated run on a ski hill and have powder experience. You can ski long, off piste pitches without stopping and rarely fall.

Frequently Asked Questions

How "good" do I have to be to go Heli-Skiing?

We recommend that you be at an intermediate or better level at your ski area, although powder experience is not necessary. We make every attempt to group skiers and boarders by ability.

What kind of skis/board should I have?

We strongly advise powder skis and boards which are available for rent from Whistler Heli-Ski for \$35.

What if the weather is bad?

We offer fantastic skiing and boarding during difficult weather in our sub-alpine terrain. However, if our helicopters are unable to fly due to safety considerations, we will cancel the day.

What is your cancellation policy?

Our flexible policy allows you to cancel up until 10:00AM the day prior to departure and still get your full money back. After 10:00AM a fee of \$200/person will be applied. We recommend guests carry travel insurance to cover costs in the event of sickness or injury prior to departure. If we cancel our day due to weather considerations, a full refund will be issued. If we cancel during the ski day, you will be refunded based on the amount of runs skied.
