

## **IMPORTANT BOOKING INFORMATION - WINTER**



All driver's must be at least 19 years old and fully licensed to drive automobiles in their country of residence.



It is mandatory for all tour participants to sign a Release of Liability and Waiver Form. Any participants under the age of 19 must have a parent or guardian present to sign on their behalf.



ALL Snowmobile Tour participants must wear a Department of Transport Safety Approved Full Faced Helmet while on tour. Dogsled participants are required to wear a protective helmet, such as a bicycle or ski / snowboard helmet.



Any cancellations within 24 hours of the departure time are subject to a full charge of the tour cost. Groups of 10 or more require 72 hour notification of cancellation. Group cancellations within 72 hours will be non-refundable.

Mandatory on all Snowmobile tours. Collision Coverage \$30 per driver for the Powderhound & Bralorne tours.





Any person suspected to be under the influence of any drugs or alcohol will not be permitted to participate in any tour. Persons denied participation will not receive a refund.



Safety regulations require that Canadian Wilderness Adventures not permit pregnant women to ride as driver or passenger on a Snowmobile or Dogsled tour.






# MINIMUM AGE RESTRICTIONS
